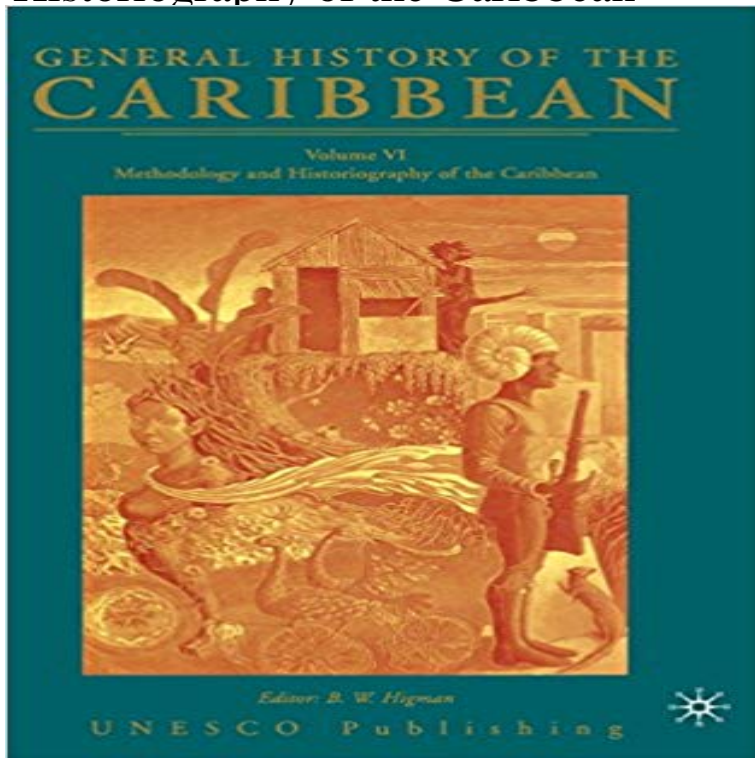


## General History of the Caribbean UNESCO Volume 6: Methodology and Historiography of the Caribbean
