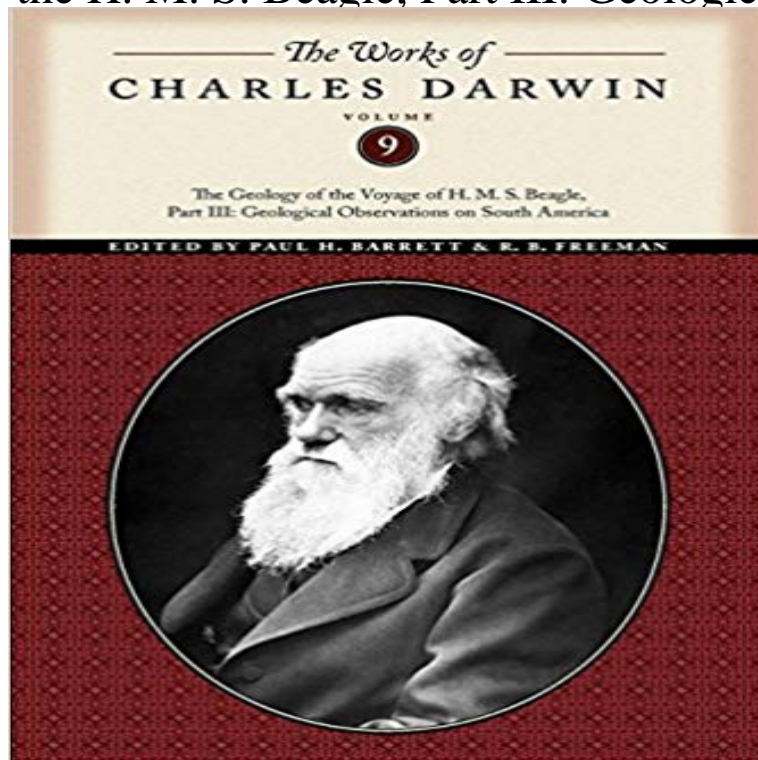


## The Works of Charles Darwin, Volume 9: The Geology of the Voyage of the H. M. S. Beagle, Part III: Geological Observations on South America
