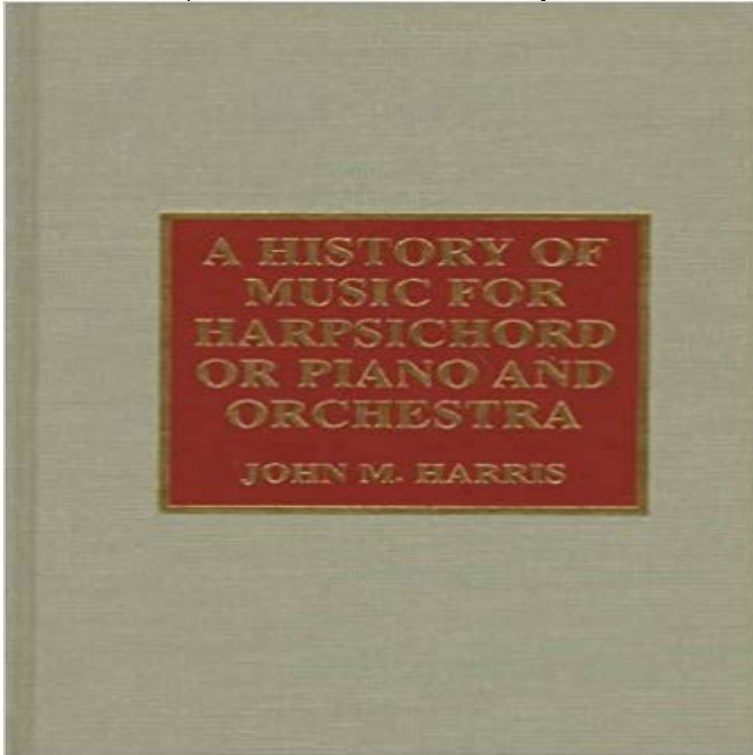


A History of Music for Harpsichord or Piano and Orchestra

The solo concerto, however, has remained a vital musical force from its birth with the exception of the organ and some harpsichord concertos by Johann Sebastian Bach.
