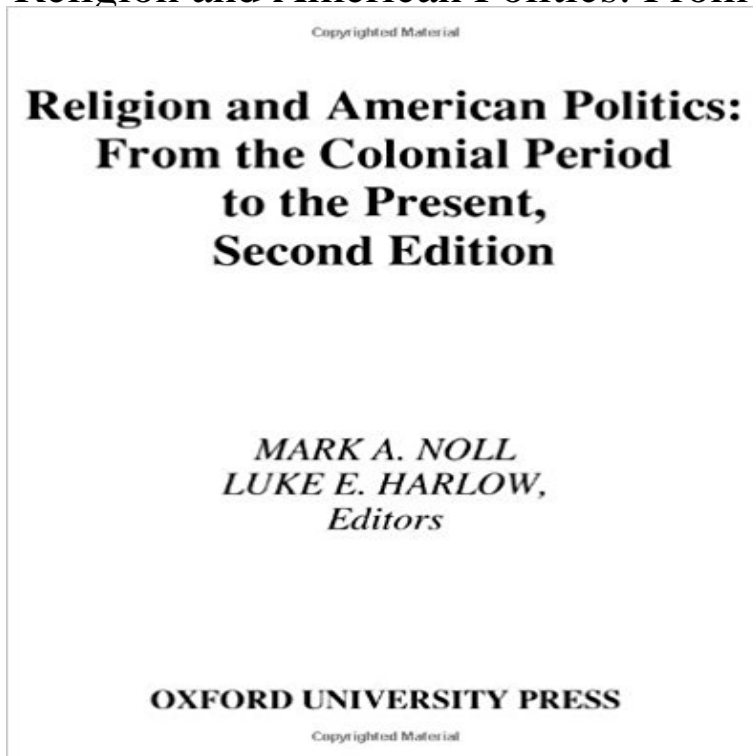


Religion and American Politics: From the Colonial Period to the Present

For this new edition, Mark Noll and new co-editor Luke Harlow offer a completely new introduction, and also commission several new pieces and eliminate several that are now out of date.
