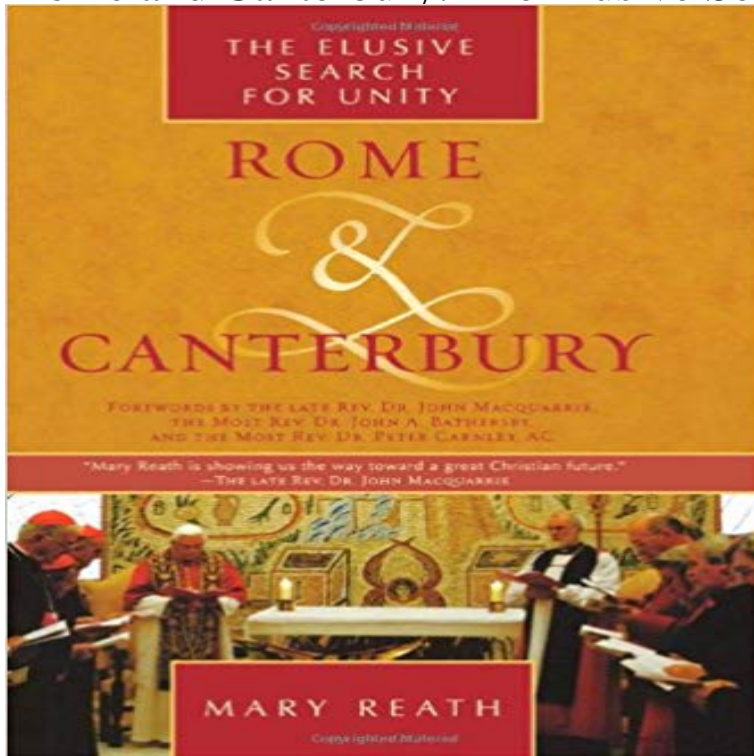


Rome and Canterbury: The Elusive Search for Unity
