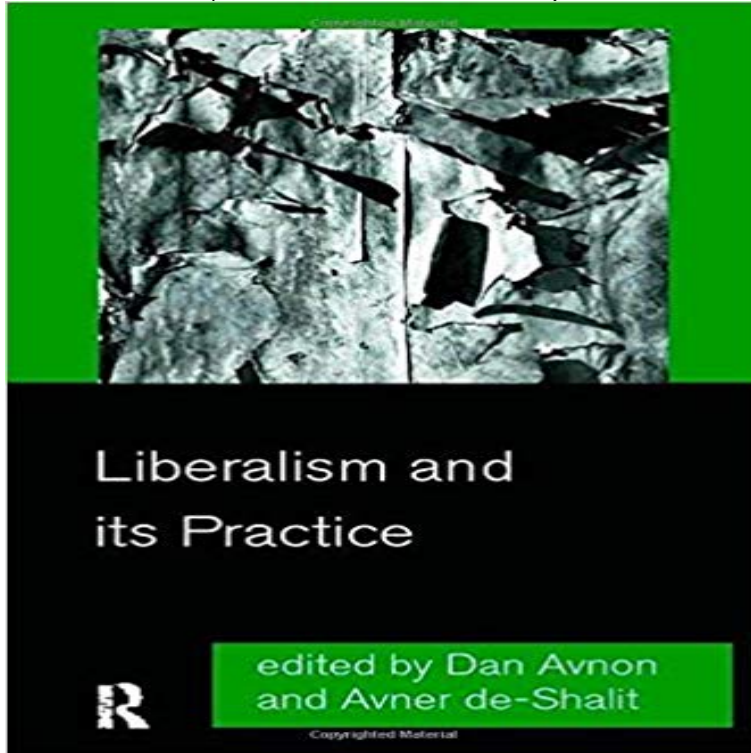


Rationality and Revolution (Studies in Marxism and Social Theory)
