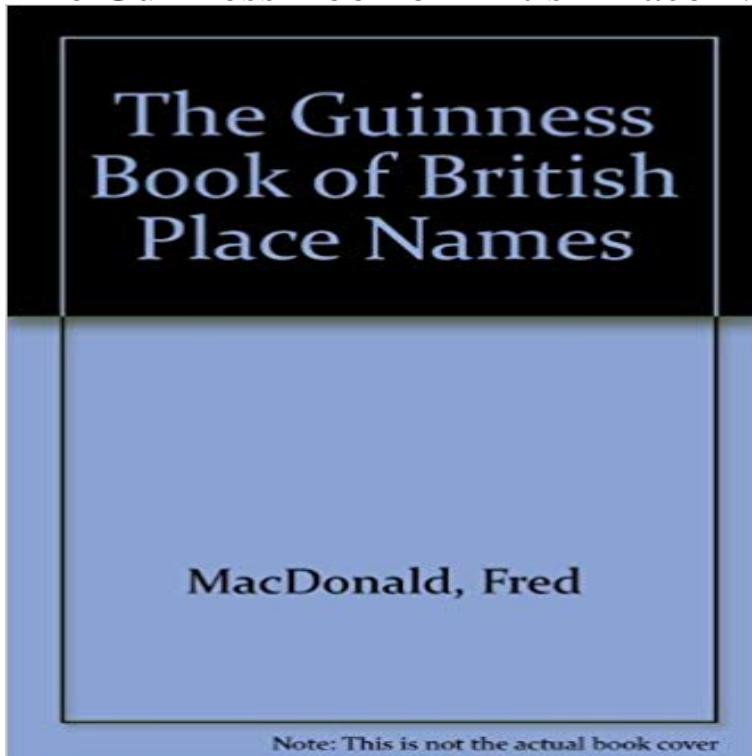


## The Guinness Book of British Place Names
