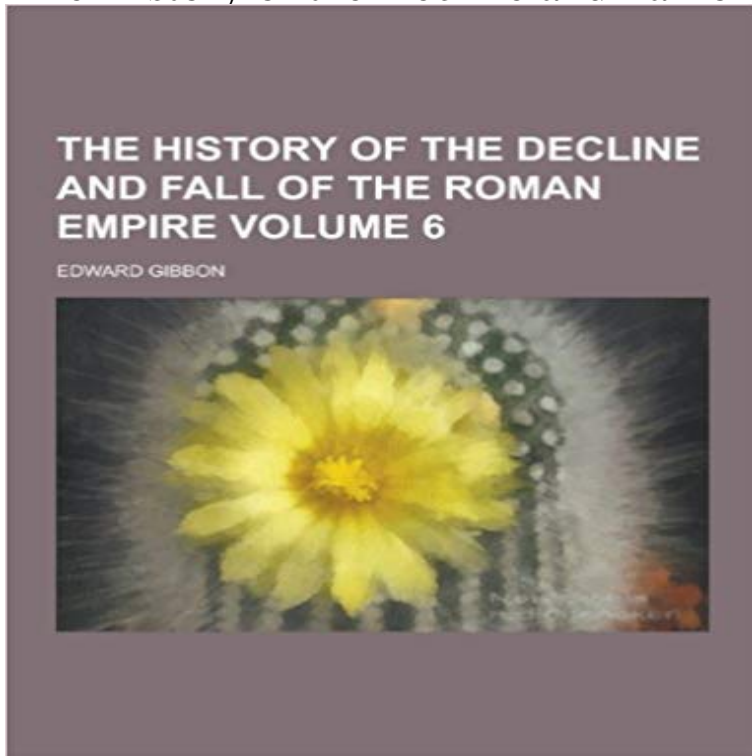

The senator Olybrius, of the Anician family, might esteem himself the lawful heir of the the West, western empire. He had married Placidia, the younger daughter of Valentinian, after she was restored by

Genseric; who still detained her sister Eudoxia, as the wife, or rather as the captive, of his...
