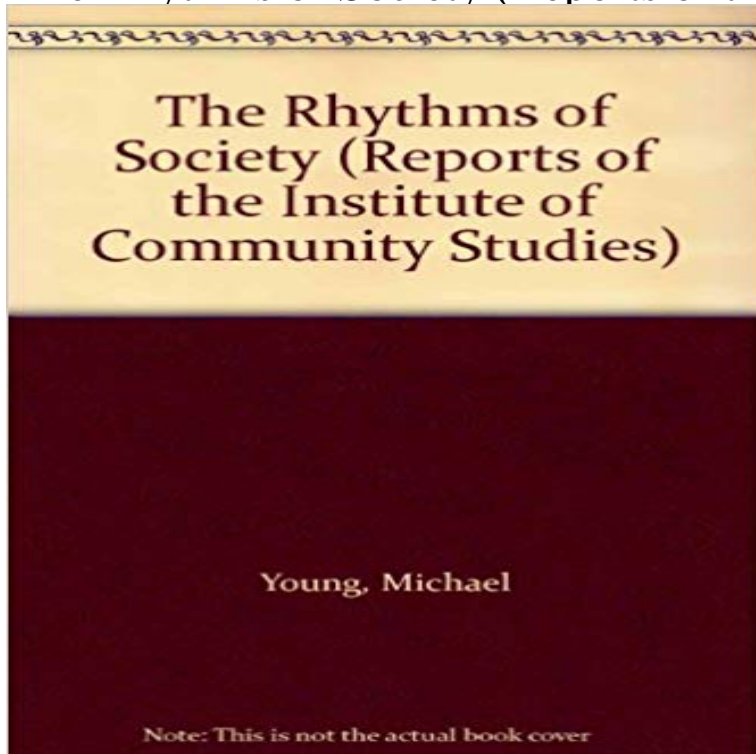


The Rhythms of Society (Reports of the Institute of Community Studies)
