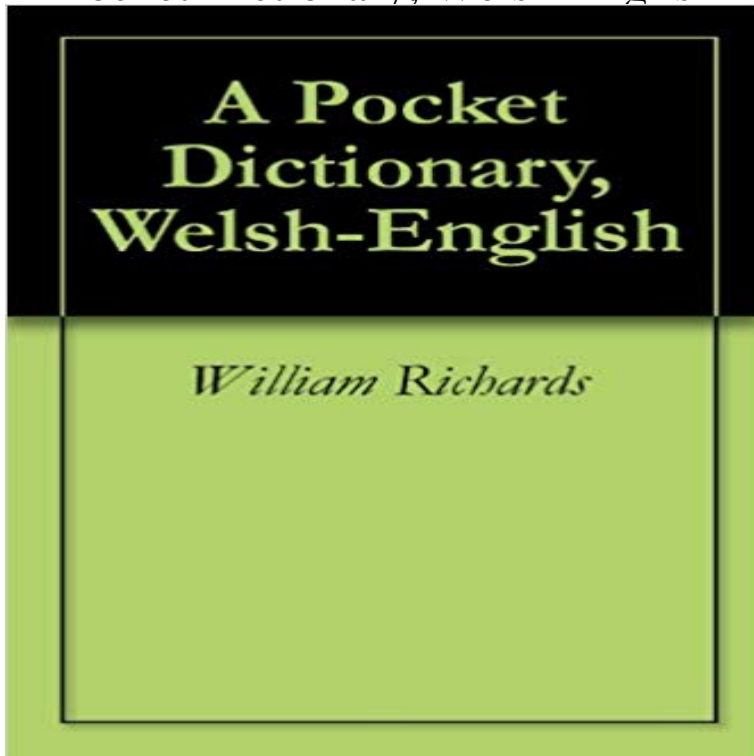


A Pocket Dictionary, Welsh-English
